This Circular provides FRAs with background to the development of the Fleetmap for the Firelink National Radio System. The Firelink Fleetmap will determine how radio terminals, control operator positions and the radio network are to be configured. The attached document describes the strategy being employed by Firelink to develop the Fleetmap to meet operational wide-area communications needs and to ensure national roaming, same service and inter-agency interoperability capability. It provides FRAs with an overview of those elements of the Fleetmap that will be determined at a national level and those elements that will be determined locally.
