



The Disposals Programme 2008

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 135 (3) and (4) of the Leasehold Reform, Housing and Urban Development Act 1993, and all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby prepares the following disposals programme:

Citation and Commencement

The programme may be cited as the Disposals Programme 2008 and shall have effect for the period beginning 1 April 2008 and ending 31 March 2010.

This programme applies in relation to disposals by local authorities in England only.

In this programme, a "Registered Social Landlord" shall be construed in accordance with Part 1 of the Housing Act 1996.

Programme

The following descriptions of disposals are included in the programme:

- Four disposals by the London Borough of Lewisham of:
 - not more than 474 dwelling houses on the Newstead Estate and Leybridge Estate in Lee to a Registered Social Landlord;
 - not more than 91 dwellings in the Telegraph Hill area to a Registered Social Landlord;

- not more than 511 dwelling houses in Hatcham Park, Lewis Silkin House, Romney Court and Harney Court in the New Cross area to a Registered Social Landlord;
 - not more than 159 dwelling houses on the Excalibur estate to a Registered Social Landlord.
- A disposal by the London Borough of Merton of not more than 6,300 dwelling houses to a Registered Social Landlord.
- A disposal by Rutland County Council of not more than 1,243 dwelling houses to a Registered Social Landlord.
- A disposal by Sedgefield Borough Council of not more than 8,583 dwelling houses to a Registered Social Landlord.
- A disposal by South Cambridgeshire District Council of not more than 5,550 dwelling houses to a Registered Social Landlord.
- A disposal by Wakefield Metropolitan District Council of not more than 23 dwelling houses to a Registered Social Landlord.
